## Five days of hands-on advanced literacy

The Literacy Task Force of Northern Wisconsin and Nicolet College are partnering to offer a five day advanced structured literacy training course for teachers, tutors, and private practitioners. This thorough and engaging program builds on the fundamentals of the Orton-Gillingham/multisensory structured language approach taught in the introductory course, which is a prerequisite to this course.

An understanding of how multisyllabic words are formed and used is essential for anyone who works with students who read, write and spell beyond an introductory level. This course will provide a basic understanding of how prefixes, suffixes, and roots are combined and used in the English language using multisensory instructional methods based on the science of language and literacy. Participants will observe sample lessons, prepare lesson plans, and engage in applying knowledge and skills learned.
